A Message From Their Majesties

Unto the beloved and noble people of An Tir do your King and Queen bear greetings,

We are very pleased to announce Our decision, in conjunction with the Kingdom Seneschal, the Kingdom Exchequer, and the rest of the An Tir Finance Committee, that the following policy will be implemented effective for September Crown this year:

In order to encourage members with children, and to ease the financial burden of large families participating in the SCA, for a trial period of one year there will be **NO GATE FEE** for any accompanied minor to any Kingdom event. Adults/parents will pay the standard gate fee but those under the age of majority will no longer pay gate fees. Note that this applies only to Kingdom events. Local or regional-level events may choose to charge fees for children.

At the end of this 12-month trial, the Financial Committee will assess the financial impact on the Kingdom and will give a recommendation to continue or terminate this policy.

Thank you to the Baron and people of the Barony of Stromgard for this idea, the initial data, and spearheading it through the Kingdom process.

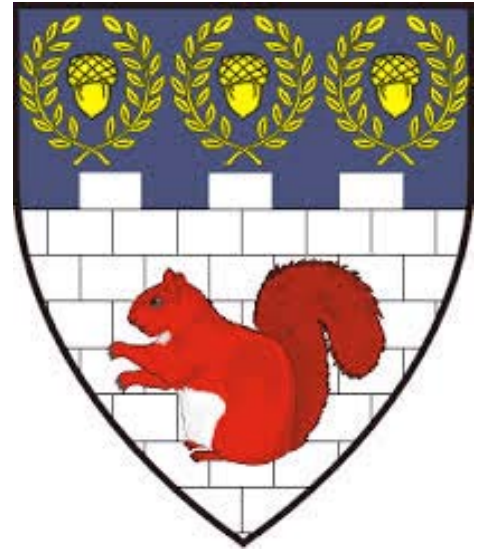
Minutes of Canton of Akornebir Council

Officer Reports:

Seneschal: HL Gudrun sent her report with HL Thorkell – Springfest and Iron & Ink were both awesome events. Upcoming events - July Coronation, 7/18 – 20, Wastekeep Sergeants, 8/9, there are 4 candidates, Squire Skaldi, HL Thorkell, HL Katherine, Mistress Marcia; Bows, Blades, Barbeque, 8/23. Reports are due August 1st for the second quarter which covers April, May and June – Get them done now and beat the rush!!

Exchequer: HL Katherine – There is \$1381.80 in the checking account. Only upcoming expense is for As You Like It. A check will need to be written for the site deposit October 1st, sooner only if someone else wants the site that date.

Old Business:

As You Like It: the DRF was submitted, and EIF is needed asap. We need an official Steward for the Event, but the members present agreed to Steward as a team. Volunteer? It was also decided to do a potluck instead of a served feast.

Other Events and Obligations:

Baron's Ball – HL Thorkell and HL Rowland will Steward this event. HL Katherine will be stepping up as Baroness at the event.

Wastekeep Yule – HL Gudrun and HL Thorkell are Event and Feast Stewards. At last year's Yule there was a class after feast, one on fighting. They would like to have another class after feast this year – suggestions? A class on Bardic presentation was suggested.

New Business:

Status of the Canton: HL Katherine shared that she and HL Gudrun had talked at Springfest about the challenge of maintaining the Canton with so few active members. With this in mind a discussion has held regarding the pros and cons of keeping the Canton active and the options available. All members present agreed that having a Canton in the eastern part of the Barony ensures that there are, or can be, activities in this area and that this is preferable to only having activities in the central part of the Barony. As the requirement for Canton status is to have a Seneschal, Exchequer and one of the following; Herald, Marshall or Minister of Arts & Sciences, plus to hold one event a year, the members present determined that we are capable of continuing and should do so. With the recent return of Lothar, Salia and Magnus to more active involvement, activity may increase sooner than expected. It was also decided that this issue should be re-visited regularly or when active membership changes significantly.

Stwed Beef

Take fair Ribbes of ffresh beef And (if thou wilt) roste hit til hit be nygh ynowe then put hit in a fair possnet caste Per-to parcely and oynons minced resons of coraung powder peper canel clowes saundres safferon and salt then caste there-to wyn and a litull vynegre set a lyd on Pe potte and lete hit boile sokingly on a faire charcoal til hit be ynough Pen lay the fflessh in dishes and the sirippe ther-vppon And serve it forth. “Take nice unsalted beef ribs, and, if you will, roast them until nearly done. Then put it in a clean posnet, add to this minced parsley and onions, currants, powdered pepper, cinnamon, cloves, saunders, saffron, and salt; then add to this wine and a little vinegar; set a lid on the pot and boil thoroughly over a good charcoal fire until it is done, then lay the meat in dishes, and serve it with the sauce over it.”

Stewed Beef Ribs

2 to 3 lbs. beef short ribs, cut into serving pieces	¼ tsp ground cloves
¼ cup fresh parsley, minced	1 tsp saunders*
1 medium onion, finely chopped	Pinch saffron, crumbled
1 cup currants	½ tsp salt
½ tsp ground pepper	2 cups white wine
½ tsp ground cinnamon	½ cup wine vinegar

Roast beef ribs on a rack in a 350o oven for about 1 hour. Place ribs in a large oven proof casserole with remaining ingredients and bake covered at 350o for an additional hour, or until tender. Skim excess fat. Serve ribs with sauce pored over.

If sauce seems too thin, you may thicken it with 1 cup soft breadcrumbs to each cup of liquid.
