Approval of Minutes: Moved & Passed

Old Business

- Yule – Thorkell: Thank you for all who attended. We had a loss of \$402.84 with an expected amount of \$400. There were 45 attendees, No gate sheet, some communication issues with event contact. Roth contacted building owns and formally communicated our issues/problems. Possible new space in Walla Walla for next/this year (2015).
- Heraldic/Scribal Symposium (Oct. 2015) – Mairghread: Ulric confirmed we can use the Pasco School Dist. Building but did not have any info about the use fee. EIF has been submitted.
- Greenwood Faire – Mairghread: Gudrun, Meagan, and I are co-stewarding. Web site is down but I emailed them and let them know that we are interested in demo space and that the castle is available for rent. New site, Columbia Point location water and electric will have to be brought in; Howard Amon is having new grass and maintenance work, so no one can use the park for events this year.
- Springfest – Stjarna: We do have a site, Lewis and Clark State park. We will be paying \$2.50 per person and they will be taking care of the Discover Passes/Issues. Tentative copy has been submitted to Baron & Baroness. Do we want a Pandibat competition / YES! / Steinbjorn will organize. Spitting Duck will submit Hours, Games, and whatever to Steward. EIS is in and class schedules are in the works.
- Baron's Ball – Fergus: The Ranger is on sick leave but will keep Sacajawea Park date reserved for us.

Officer's Reports

Seneschal: Facebook is a wonderful tool; however we cannot use Facebook to make Official Announcements. It must published using an officially approved source such as the yahoo groups, steps, Baronial calendar, or in the Word. If you need help, call me and I will help you.
